Children's Section – Free Entry

General Rules:

- Exhibits must be delivered to the Home Industries site on Friday 16th January between 1pm and 6pm. All exhibitors will be off site by 6.05pm.
- **JUDGING TO COMMENCE 6.30PM FRIDAY EVENING.**
- **Please bring the correct entry forms completed with you.**
- All exhibits are entered at competitors own risk.
- Exhibits must be picked up by 4pm on Saturday 17th January or they will be disposed of. Exhibits may only be removed from the building after prize giving and prior to 4pm.
- **All exhibits must be grown or made/created by the exhibitor.**
- Photos must be from amateur photographers only in the photo section or they will be disqualified. NO editing of images or photo manipulation unless stated.
- Presentation of ribbons and trophies will be at 3pm Saturday 17th January.
- Classes may be split if necessary
- Exhibits entered must not have been previously shown before at a Winton A&P Show.
- **Sponsor's prizes may be awarded**
- **Judges decision will be final.**

Open- For anyone that has entered previously at the Winton A&P Show and won prizes or won at other A&P shows.

Novice For anyone that has never entered in the Winton A&P Show Home Industries, or has entered previously and never won a prize in a section. Ages 14+ can enter this Novice Section

POINTS & JUDGING EXPLAINED:

POINTS:

1st Place = 3 Points
2nd Place = 2 Points
3rd Place = 1 Point
4th- HC = 0 Points

For every section points are added up for each placing and an overall winner and runner up is determined from the points total. Most Points overall for the Home Industries is established from the overall totals from each section.

The more you enter and receive a placing, the more points you will gain in total.

JUDGING:

Each exhibitor is given a number when entering to place on their entries. The Judges have no knowledge who the numbers belong to or who has entered entries.

We try to place the numbers where they are not visible on the entries. This allows the judging to be unbiased.

We use a different judge for each section and allow the judges to interpret and judge each class as they see fit.

The judges decision is final.

Trophies to be awarded for:

Country Jewel Trophy for Most Points overall across all sections.
Jessica Irwin Memorial Tray for Baking - Most Points Under 17 Years.

- Removable lids on pickles, Cellophane jam covers on jam/jelly.
- Exhibits may be opened for judging.
- No names on the jars please.
- All jars must be clean, labelled and dated.
- **All exhibits must be homemade.**
- **Limit of 2 per class**

- To be judged on quality- Vegetables and fruit must be washed.
- 5cm leaf stalk on root vegetables. Brassicas leaves left on except Broccoli.
- To be presented on a white disposable plate where possible.
- No commercially grown produce accepted.
- Limit of 2 entries per class

(You can enter up to the limit per class but you will only pay the maximum of \$10, for example you may have 15 entries in Baking but only pay \$10)

- Each exhibit must be presented on a white disposable plate (side plate size please, other than Cake, Pie or loaf).
- Please cover with a snaplock bag or glad wrap.
- Baking will be opened and may be sampled for judging.
- 1 entry per batch- Limit 2 entries per class.
- **No commercial bakers**
