- Exhibits must be delivered to the Home Industries site on Friday 19th January between 1pm and 7pm. All exhibitors will be off site by 7.10pm. JUDGING TO COMMENCE 7.30PM FRIDAY EVENING.
- PHOTOGRAPHY to be judged at 11am on show day.
- **Please bring the correct entry forms completed with you.**
- All exhibits are entered at competitor's own risk.
- Exhibits must be picked up by 4pm on Saturday 20th January or they will be disposed of. Exhibits may only be removed from the building after prize giving and prior to 4pm.
- All exhibits must be grown or made/created by the exhibitor.
- Photos must be from amateur photographers only in the photo section or they will be disqualified. NO editing of images or photo manipulation unless stated.
- Presentation of ribbons and trophies will be at 3pm Saturday 20th January.
- Classes may be split if necessary
- Exhibits entered must not have been previously shown before at a Winton A&P Show.
- No commercially produced exhibits allowed
- **Sponsor's prizes may be awarded**
- **Judges decision will be final.**

For the Blokes

Easy Beer Bread

3 cups flour

3 teaspoons baking powder

1 teaspoon salt

1 can beer 400mls – If your can is smaller, make up the amount with water.
Don't use low-alcohol beer

1 handful of grated cheese

Preheat the oven to 200 C . Mix the flour, baking powder, salt and beer in a large bowl and combine well.

Tip into a well-greased loaf tin. Sprinkle the cheese on top of the dough.

Bake the loaf for 40 – 60 minutes. You might have to experiment with cooking times depending on your oven.
